

AMERICAN SADDLEBRED HORSE BREEDER FUTURITIES OF TEXAS

OPEN FUTURITY YEARLING JACKPOT

Rules and Deadlines

*****this is an OPTIONAL program*****

ELIGIBILITY

Any American Saddlebred yearling that is was nominated to the American Saddlebred Horse Breeders Open Futurity of Texas as a weanling is eligible to be nominated to the Texas Open Futurity Yearling Jackpot. It did not have to show as a weanling. The yearling must also be nominated to the American Saddlebred Open Futurity of Texas as a yearling.

HOW TO ENTER

A yearling colt or filly may be entered in one of the following three ways:

REGULAR NOMINATION

Total fee of \$100.00 per yearling is due by May 15 of each year.

(If you choose this option, do NOT pay the late nomination or post entry fees.)

LATE NOMINATION

Total fee of \$200.00 per yearling is due by September 1 of each year.

(Pay this amount if you did not choose Regular Nomination option. Do NOT pay post entry fee.)

POST ENTRY

Total fee of \$400.00 per yearling is due 24 hours prior to the first session of the horse show (State Fair of Texas, in September of each year). (Pay this amount if you did not choose Regular Nomination or Late Nomination.)

YEARLING JACKPOT FUND AND PAYOUT

The total yearling jackpot fund is to be paid out every year in the yearling championship class of the American Saddlebred Horse Breeders Open Futurity of Texas. Prize money is to be paid to the top five eligible Yearling Jackpot Foals placing in the top ten ribbons. The money paid out for the Yearling Jackpot is totally separate, and is paid out in addition to the regular American Saddlebred Horse Breeders Open Futurity of Texas money.

Judges will be asked to place the entire class and, in the unlikely event that there are not any Yearling Jackpot foals finishing in the top 10, the highest placed eligible yearling will be awarded 100% of the prize fund.

There will be no return of entry fees, and designation of Yearling Jackpot foals may not be changed after nomination.
